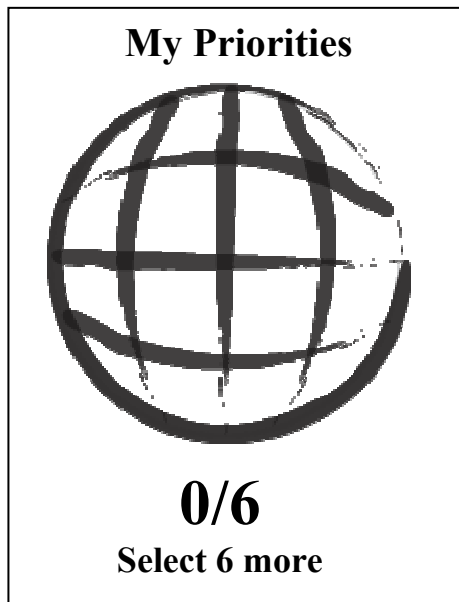

The World Association of Girl Guides and Girl Scouts (WAGGGS) has teamed up with United Nations and other partners in defining the next set of global goals for the Post-2015 agenda through its innovative survey known as “MY World”.

MY World is a global survey for citizens led by the United Nations and partners. It aims to know the people’s priorities and views which will guide the global leaders in identifying new development agenda for the world.

MY World asks individuals which six (6) of sixteen (16) possible issues they think would make the most difference to their lives. The sixteen issues came up from the research implemented by UN are as follows:

✓ Freedom from discrimination and persecution
✓ Better transport and roads
✓ Affordable and nutritious food
✓ Better job opportunities
✓ Access to clean water and sanitation
✓ An honest and responsive government
✓ Better healthcare
✓ Phone and internet access
✓ Protection against crime and violence
✓ Action taken on climate change
✓ Political freedoms
✓ A good education
✓ Equality between men and women
✓ Support for people who can’t work
✓ Reliable energy at home
