The Girl Scouts of the Philippines is invited to participate in the following international events/programme:

I. **BE PREPARED (BP) QUEST 2013**

Camp Christine, Singapore
June 23 to 27, 2013

The BP Quest is a biennial event organized by the International Committee of Girl Guides Singapore. It consists of four (4) key challenges which will test participants on Girl Scouting/Girl Guiding knowledge and skills in the following aspects of the programme:

- WAGGGS and the United Nations
- Girl Scouting/Girl Guiding in the Asia Pacific Region
- Girl Guiding in Singapore
- Knowledge in Girl Scouting/Girl Guiding skills e.g. First Aid, Knots, Map and Compass, Fauna and Flora, etc.

Team/Mechanics

The team should be composed of four (4) members. They should answer 60 multiple choice questions in 60 minutes. The team may use the smartphone, i-Pad or notebook to assist them in the challenge.

Open to three girls aged 14 to 17 years old and one adult leader.
